DAKOTAH MEADOWS RV PARK RULES

1. Only one camping unit and one vehicle permitted per RV site.
2. Tents are not permitted on or adjacent to RV sites.
3. Visitors and extra vehicles must park in the general Dakotah Meadows parking lot.
4. Quiet time is between 9:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. Please be considerate of those around you.
5. Fires are allowed on grills or in fire rings only and must be attended at all times.
6. No cutting of trees, branches or shrubs.
7. No defacing, destruction or misuse of property.
8. The speed limit on all roads within the resort is 10 mph.
9. Only licensed drivers may operate scooters, motorcycles, motorbikes, 4-wheelers, 3 wheelers, or any motorized vehicle within the park. These same vehicles may be driven only to and from your RV site.
10. Public possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.
11. Possession and/ or consumption of controlled substances or being under the influence of a controlled substance is strictly prohibited.
12. Cleaning fish, dishwashing, or shampooing pets in the laundry room or restrooms is not permitted.
13. Use dump station for disposal of waste (gray) water.
14. It is the responsibility of each guest to keep their RV site neat and orderly.
15. In case of severe weather please seek shelter in the Headquarters Storm Shelter. You may be directed to alternative locations.
16. Laundry may not be hung on exterior clotheslines or on any exterior structure.
17. Dakotah Meadows reserves the right to ask any guest to leave the RV Park.
18. Seven day maximum stay, with minimum 30 days between stays. Extended stays available upon request and subject to approval.
19. Firearms are strictly forbidden. Violations of this policy may result in exclusion and fines.
20. Any and all fireworks are prohibited.
21. All park rules apply to registered guests and their visitors.



Absolutely no washing of any RVs or Vehicles at your RV site.

ADDITIONAL RULES FOR TIPI RENTAL

1. For your safety, do not remove the support poles or the lace sticks above and below the door flap.
2. The rain diverter inside the tent must stay in place.
3. Absolutely no fire rings inside tipi.
4. Use the restroom, shower and laundry facilities at your convenience.
5. Dispose of garbage properly.

PET RULES

Pets are allowed. Pets must be restrained on a maximum 8 foot leash. All droppings must be picked up immediately.

Pets may not be left leashed or unattended. Exterior kennels are not permitted. We reserve the right to limit number of pets.

Failure to check out by noon will result in being charged regular rate for one extra day and you will be asked to leave.

PLAYGROUND RULES

Children must be supervised by an adult while in the play area. Unsupervised children will be told to leave the play area.

Pets are not allowed inside the fenced play area.
